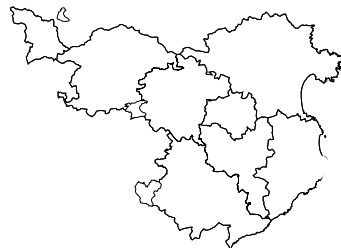
The fishing tourism experience involves spending the day fishing on board a real fishing vessel, setting off from the fishing port of Palamós.

The *llagut*, as it is called in Catalan, is a typical Mediterranean rowing boat. With seats for eight rowers plus a coxswain, it captures an exceptional spirit of teamwork and encourages a strong relationship between the crew. Learning how to row increases different abilities and helps people discover facets of their personality that they would perhaps be unaware of in the office.

While learning the different manoeuvres you will also be put in situations that occur in the working world: decision-making, overcoming difficulties, reacting quickly, leading groups, working as a team, and more. All of this will take place surrounded by the calm of the sea, the soothing sounds of the oars on the water, and the boat gliding forwards with every stroke.

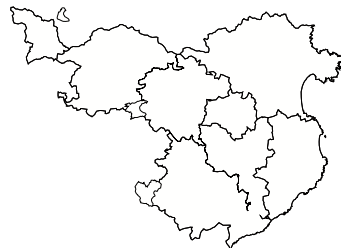
During this activity you will discover the history and different parts of the *llagut*, and you will start to learn the basic principles of rowing techniques. We will visit coves that are difficult to access by land, and whenever you feel like it and the sea allows, you will be able to go for a swim. To finish off, if there are a minimum of two *llaguts* (16 people), you will be able to enjoy the unique experience of a regatta with your workmates.

Sand traps. Restoring the dune system in the bay of L'Estartit-Pals

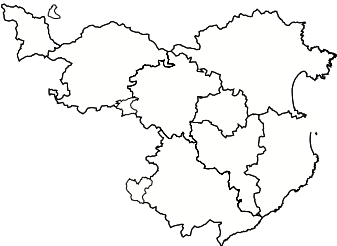

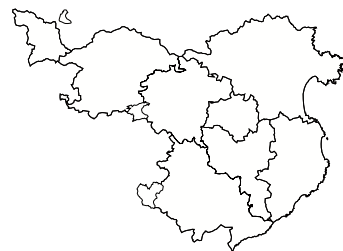

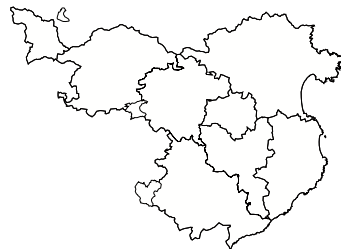

Culture

When talking about the culture in the Costa Brava and the Girona Pyrenees, you are taken back to the dawn of civilization. By order of antiquity, you can discover megalithic monuments in the Albera and Gavarres massifs; prehistoric caves in Serinyà; Iberian, Greek and Roman villages along the coast, especially in Empúries; and Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque and Art Deco architecture on display throughout the area.

From the Middle Ages onwards the region has preserved such impressive locations as Sant Pere de Rodes and Ripoll, where the legacy of a thousand-year-old history can still be felt.

In recent years, artists –including the genius Salvador Dalí in particular– have interpreted our cultural and scenic environment in a very different way, capturing it in incomparable artistic creations. Altogether, over 55 museums and 550 monuments fill this region with culture and tradition.

Nature

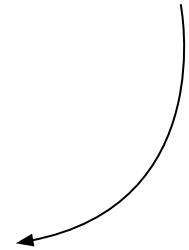

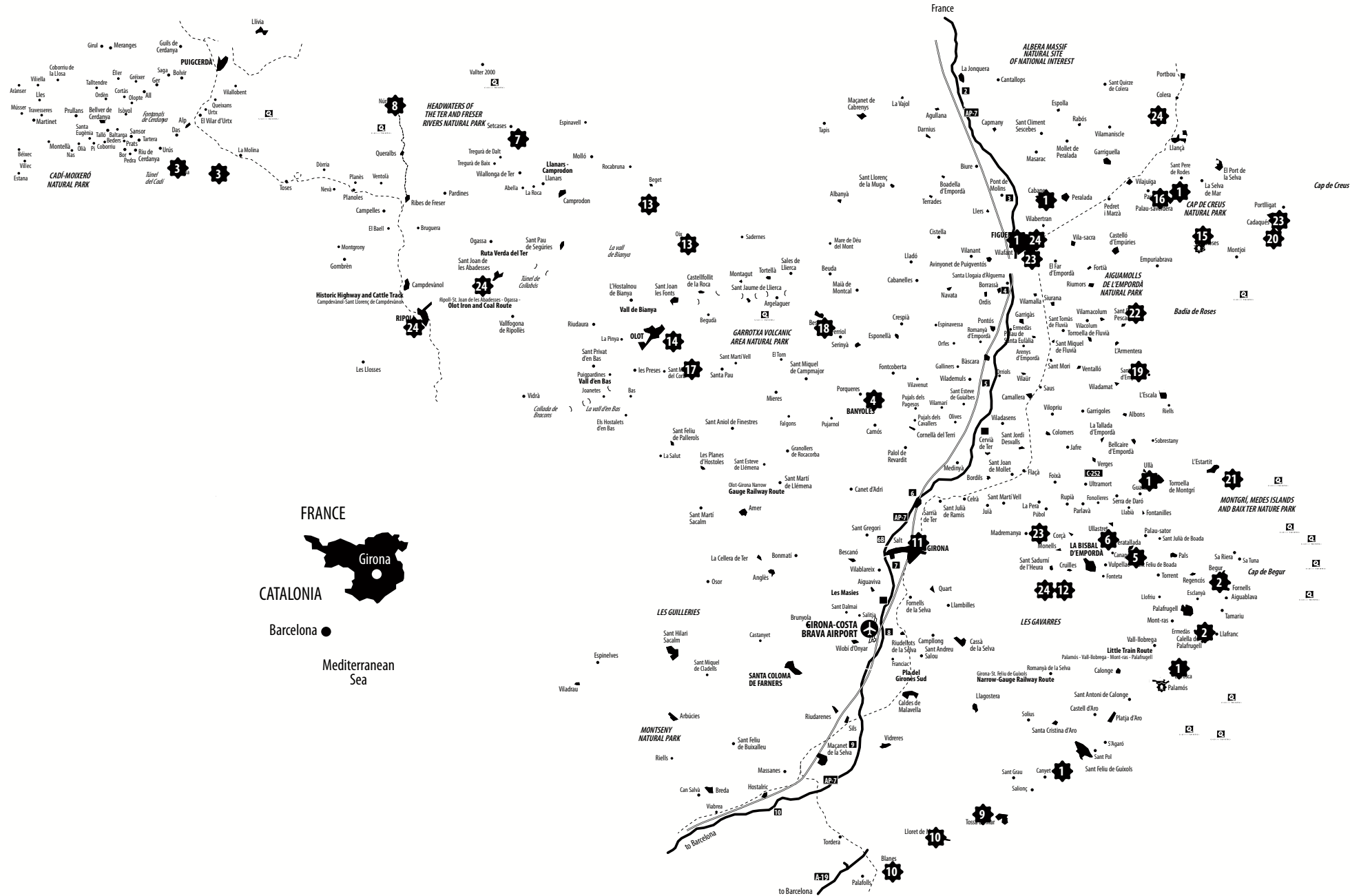
