Tracking & Trip Status updates in Real Time

On-Site – colour code yellow

When the driver arrives at the pickup point they must use the driver app to progress the job status to “on-site”. If using the backup phone numbers, they must call the number stated on the SMS received from TBR.

POB – Passenger on Board – colour code blue

When the client is on board, before moving off they must use the Driver App to progress the job status to “POB”. If using the backup phone numbers, the driver must call the number stated on the SMS received from TBR.

Stopped and start – colour code blue

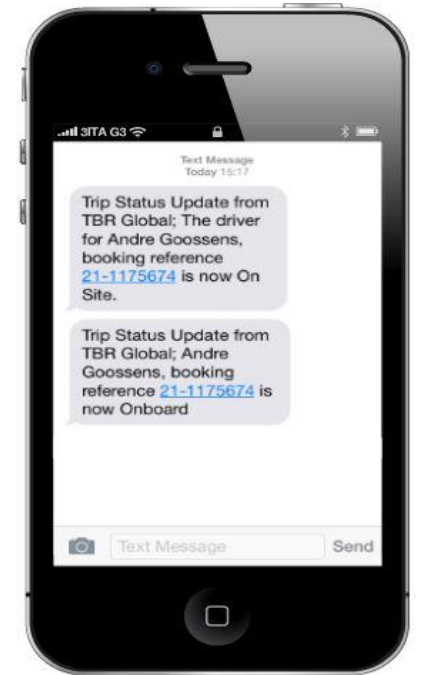
The driver has the option to press the ‘stop’ status. This indicates the driver has stopped and the passenger exited the vehicle and the car remains on stand-by as required. This information is time stamped and geo-mapped online for audit purposes. Once the passenger(s) is back on board, the driver will change his status to “start” to continue the scheduled journey. All of which can be tracked ‘live’ and reported on post job fulfilment.

Dropped – colour code orange

When the driver drops the client off at their final destination the driver must use the Driver App to progress the job status to “dropped”. If using the backup phone numbers, the driver must call the number stated on the SMS received from TBR. This call must only be made once the job for that particular day is completed i.e., the car is no longer required by the client(s) for that day.

Cancelled – colour code grey

Jobs can only be cancelled by a TBR staff member and follow the agreed NBA project terms and conditions. Each of these job statuses act as control mechanisms for the service TBR provides. Therefore, it is essential that each step of the process is followed.

TRAINING

TBR take great pride in the skill, knowledge and understanding that all our employees and freelancers possess. Training will be an essential component to ensure successful delivery of the programme and deliverables.

All training will be identified and analysed at step 2 in the project planning stages with all training fully delivered by step 3.

TBR will provide all training materials such as:

- ✓ **Project overview** - project details, objectives, onsite structure (including key tasks for each role), different sites, timings, schedules, and expected deliverables
- ✓ **Driver manual** - standards, expectations and best practice, this will also provide an overview of routes
- ✓ **Route Checks** – All drivers will carry out set route checks to ensure the exact routing is followed
- ✓ **Bespoke driver app** – process on how to provide an update on live GPS status as well as accurate update to jobs and live passenger data, providing notifications
- ✓ **TBR system training** - inputting and updating reservations, understanding status of each job, personalised name boards and how this information all links to driver app

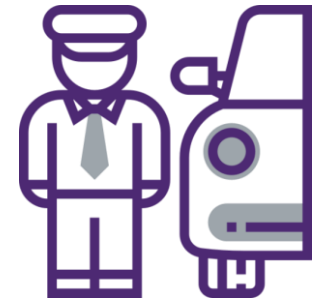
DRIVER STANDARDS

Chauffeur Driver Checks

- All chauffeurs are PCO certified - which requires a medical certificate and security disclosure checks
- Chauffeurs are assessed on driving ability, local knowledge, experience and etiquette with clients
- Over 50% of the chauffeurs are ROSPA certified
- Regular Quality Control checks are conducted on the chauffeurs and vehicles to maintain highest quality standard

Coach Driver Checks

- All drivers are handpicked by recommendation or references
- All drivers are DBS checked, have a driver qualification card and must have a clean licence
- All drivers are CPC qualified and must have a refresher every 5 years
- All drivers are assessed by our ROSPA qualified Training and Compliant Manager
- All drivers must have an outstanding knowledge of the UK and international roads
- Drivers' licences are on a stringent 6 monthly check



OPERATIONAL SITUATIONS

Scenario 1: Accidents

- Drivers, if not harmed, must check if anyone is seriously injured. Police and ambulance must be called immediately
- If clients are safe and uninjured, they must vacate the vehicle to a place of safety and driver must call the transport manager to notify issue and request back up vehicle
- If police are involved at any stage in the accident, please note the officer's details
- Our clients security will become the decision maker in all people related matters (transport, etc.)
- The driver needs to administer first aid in accordance to the training guidelines
- All chauffeurs have a 'bump card', detailing TBR's insurer and their contact details

Scenario 2: Breakdown

- TBR will provide a backup MPV & Full-Size Coach dedicated as coverage should any breakdown incident occur.
- The back up vehicle will cover the service/s during the period the assigned vehicle is being repaired by the Maintenance assist team.
- The driver must call fleet manager to notify issue and state if there is a guest in the vehicle or if the driver is on the way to the pick-up point
- The driver must call the relevant breakdown assistance team (Mercedes Assist)
- Fleet manager will then assess the situation and backup vehicle will be delivered as soon as possible
- Passengers will then continue with their journey and will arrive safely at their destination

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

Scenario 1: No contact with driver

- Should the controller not able to reach driver one hour before
- 2nd attempted call
- Contact on-site team (lead driver, project manager)
- Contact Paris control
- 3rd attempted call
- Lead driver source alternative
- Project manager communicates issue to venue staff
- London control on back up for additional resource
- System updated with alternative driver
- Alternative driver dispatched
- PM communicates new driver details
- London control continue to reach driver

Scenario 2: Driver unable to work

- Driver calls on-site lead driver
- Lead driver contacts on-site team project manger
- Project manager contacts London control
- Lead driver source alternative
- Project manager communicates issue to venue staff
- London control on back up for additional resource
- System updated with alternative driver
- Alternative driver dispatched
- PM communicates new driver details
- London control prepares for remaining days

SUSTAINABILITY

There is a pressing need to reduce global emissions to prevent catastrophic and irreversible climate change. Taking this into account, TBR has established a dedicated team, whose sole focus is to ensure sustainable practices are implemented in all areas of our work and emissions are minimised for all events globally. To successfully achieve this, there has already been several procedures and technology implemented.

TBR wants to lead by example when it comes to sustainability, with a strong desire to create a legacy. To achieve this, TBR is constantly seeking ways to improve processes and evaluate successes and shortfalls. The success previous events was due to our genuine interest in the environment and attention to detail from the outset. TBR continues to pass this culture down to our employees and incorporate sustainability in our extensive onboarding processes and on-going training.

Sustainable Initiatives

An example of TBR's ongoing commitment to sustainability, is our policy on offsetting our CO2 emissions. Partnering with Carbon Footprint, to make a difference globally. TBR have been awarded several certificates for this commitment which has resulted in preserving wildlife, such as planting trees in the UK which offset six tonnes CO2e. An additional testament to our continued focus on the environment was our success in offsetting 264 tonnes of CO2e by supporting solar/wind projects in the Philippines, China, and India.

In the project planning stages, TBR will work with the SMC to outline a clear metrics of success with timeframes in relation to sustainable initiatives they wish to deliver. TBR will effectively work alongside the project-specific sustainability consultant by utilising risk assessments, solely to highlight any potential risks in terms of sustainability and report this to the consultant along with a detailed plan of how the findings will be mitigated going forward.

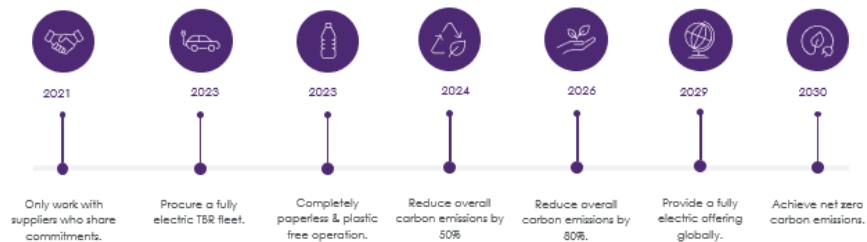
With the use of an in-house live data system, information is transmitted from our vehicles. This information includes, but is not limited to, the speed of our vehicles, idling time, routes taken, mileage and the vehicle type. The information is recorded, allowing TBR to publish reports and store the information for use at a later date, whilst adhering to all data protection legislation. As reports are published, communication can be quickly delivered to our drivers and any changes can be completed such as advising a more carbon friendly route for the journey. With prior agreement TBR will commit to the reporting of CO2 emissions used for the duration of the event.

To further enhance our commitment to sustainability we will encourage the following:

- ✓ Paperless event
- ✓ Where possible training to be delivered remotely, mitigating the need for unnecessary travel
- ✓ Onsite recycling for transport staff
- ✓ No one-use plastic bottles to be used in vehicles

With use of our online platforms, such as LinkedIn, TBR regularly communicates the importance of sustainability. By promoting sustainability, TBR hopes that its competitors will join in on the attempt to create a more conscious business environment that becomes a strong industry standard in the future.
