**SEA BASS IN A SALT CRUST, WITH LEMON AND CAPER DRESSING**

**Ingredients:**  
 1 whole wild sea bass (approx 750g)  
 400g sea salt (locally Hales Mins)  
 5 egg whites  
 Handful fresh dill  
 1 tsp Herbes de Provence  
 1 lemon, thinly sliced

**Method:**

- Preheat the oven to 180°C.
- To make the crust, whisk up to 5 egg whites to soft peaks. Chop the dill and fold into the egg mixture along with the Herbes de Provence. Mix all of the salt into this – it will form a kind of paste. If it's too dry, add a splash of water.
- Remove the head and tail from the sea bass and trim off the fins. Open the cavity of the fish and stuff with thin slices of lemon.
- On a baking sheet, lay approximately one third of the mixture in a line along the spine in the shape of a fish.
- Place the fish on top, then cover with the remaining mixture, making sure the fish is covered on all sides, then place it in the oven for 25–30 minutes. The mixture will look crispy.
- Take to the table and crack open, to the sound of glass and applause from your dinner guests. Serve with a lemon and caper dressing.

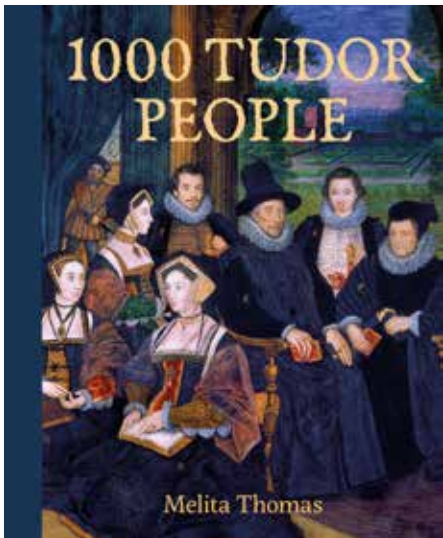

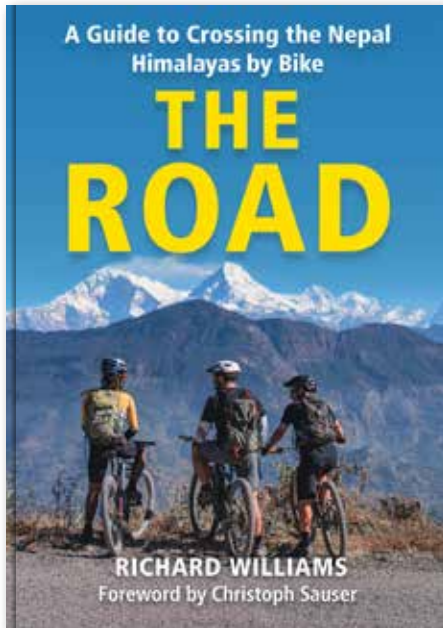

### Day 1: Dadeldhura – Silghadi

**Distance:** 108km  
**Cycling Time:** 20h  
**Climbing:** 1120m  
**Technical Level:** 1/3  
**Endurance Level:** 4/5

**Route Summary:**  
 A fully paved route. Beginning at the starting point, Ugranas temple, there is a short climb followed by a fast and sweeping (then downhill) to Bantawa bridge and the valley.

**Route:** The road follows the Seti River valley with a gently descending undulating gradient for 60km to the town of Dipayal. Cross the Seti bridge then turn immediately sharp right, and cross Derasa Khaba bridge for the last 48km climb up to the town of Silghadi.

**There are many food stalls and snack shops along the valley road. Recommended for hot food – Twin Café (the glass panini) plus after Lunch/tea bridge, on the left side of the road. The busy town of Dipayal**

Elevation of Day 1

is also a good place to eat and stock up on supplies before the final climb of the day to Silghadi.

**Day 1 Journal Excerpt:**  
 Looking for an appropriate starting point for The Road has been quite a challenge. It has to be in the far west, close to the Indian border. Dadeldhura was recommended for its location and amenities for stocking up for the start of the trip. Last night, we were told by a local that there was a festival in a nearby Hindu temple the very next day, just a few kilometers out of town that we should maybe check out. We decided to start early and to take a look.

As we rolled our bikes down to Ugranas early this morning it became clear very quickly that today was going to be a special day. The road was filled with swarms of ladies in beautiful crimson saris going towards a mass of colour in the valley below. Young boys in pristine white shirts peering around with excitement as the crowds swarmed and flickered as we rolled further into a sea of colour, smoke and fragrant incense.

We dismounted the bikes, walked around the festival, in and around the temple. We seemed invisible to the pilgrims and worshippers – all entranced by this quite magical

religious occasion. The mass of people, the smoke, the smells, the swarming, clothes and jewellery seemed so exotic and spiritual, it was hard not to get swept up with the spirit of the gathering. The vibrant colours of yellow, red and orange so synonymous with Hindu culture, made the festival seem so bright and alive. The exquisite flower arrangements and garlands as well, showing the love and dedication of the people to their religious beliefs. There were various sage-like figures dotted in and around the temple grounds who were giving blessings for a small donation. We were soon covered in red and yellow dust that fell from

our foreheads onto our clothes as we wandered around. The atmosphere of life, colour, faith and spirituality that we stumbled on by chance on this morning made us realize very quickly that the gates of Ugranas Temple were the perfect starting point for the long and difficult journey of The Road.
