BEE INVOLVED!

There is always a buzz at Fairmont Waterfront with over 40,000 resident honeybees making a beeline for the rooftop garden. Since 2008, the hotel has worked in tandem with Julia Common, co-founder of Hives for Humanity and Chief Beekeeper at Fairmont Waterfront, to maintain and winter the hives. With increasing concerns about Colony Collapse Disorder in North American honeybees, there was an opportunity to house hives on the rooftop garden. Mason bees also help to pollinate flowers in nearby parks and an observation hive displays the bees in action.

SEE THE BEES

The hotel's Bee Team offers complimentary tours every day at 3:00pm (seasonally) of the organic garden and apiary. Visitors learn about the honeybees, mason bees and pollinator bees who call the rooftop home, see the Pollinator Hotel, and peek in the observation hive.

HIVES FOR HUMANITY

Fairmont Waterfront is a longtime supporter of Hives for Humanity, who first introduced mason bees in April 2014 to the hotel's garden as part of the amazing Pollinator Corridor Project. This community outreach initiative is committed to populating Vancouver green spaces with mason bees and houses in an effort to build up local bee populations. These super pollinators live in tiny tubes and don't produce honey but are great for the garden (and the planet). They are very docile members of the bee family and live in harmony with the existing honey bees. www.hivesforhumanity.com



OH HONEY!

The annual honey harvest brings in over 200 pounds of honey from up to 250,000 resident and off site honeybees. The bees forage over 30 square kilometers and bring back honey from over 60 different species of plants, collecting the Fairmont Waterfront's largest volumes of honey from blackberry, dandelion, fire weed, clover, cherry and a variety of other indigenous plants. These bees will visit over one million flowers to produce one pound of honey. So what do they do with all that honey? The hotel uses it in cocktails, desserts, salad dressing, and even our signature gin distilled directly from honey made in partnership with Wayward Distillery!

TAKE TIME TO SMELL THE ROSEMARY, THYME... AND LAVENDER

The hotel's 2,100 square foot herb garden was introduced in 1995 and was one of the earliest (if not the first) green roof in Vancouver. Located on the third floor, the organically farmed garden has views of the harbor on one side, skyscrapers on the other and heady fragrances from a variety of herbs, fruits and vegetables. It also serves as a bird sanctuary, making it home to 10 species of local songbirds. Green practices include the release of 750 ladybugs to control aphid populations as natural pest control, and planting purple vetch which replaces the need for fertilization and promotes nitrogen for optimum soil conditions. The Chef can often be seen snipping produce and edible flowers for use on the plant-to-plate menus in ARC.



A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE

Take a cultural and culinary adventure with us in partnership with Talaysay Tours. Explore the beauty of Vancouver's natural landscape and learn about Aboriginal culture firsthand with these unique and intimate eco-tourism experiences. We recommend the Talking Trees tour, a walking tour through the world renowned old growth forest of Stanley Park that is easily enjoyed by all ages and fitness levels. Your local First Nations guide will share ancient and contemporary stories, legends, ways of life. Hear the many stories of the region as well as with cultural and scientific knowledge of the Northwest coast trees and plants. Every natural element is deemed sacred and has its own special story, having a purpose which supported the local Indigenous societies for generations. KEEPING IT IN THE COMMUNITY

Since 2016, Fairmont Waterfront has partnered with Britannia Elementary, a local inner-city school, to bring a grade seven class into our kitchen to be mentored by our culinary team. The students spend the day cooking and learning how to prepare for a large banquet event, while learning about career opportunities within the hospitality industry.

The following day, with the support of volunteer hotel colleagues, the grade seven class prepares and serves a four course formal dinner to 150+ guests. Britannia Elementary School receives 100% of ticket proceeds and cash bar sales to support a cultural exchange program for the students. As of 2023, Fairmont Waterfront has raised over \$90,000 for Britannia Elementary.

LIFE IS COMPLICATED, GOOD FOOD SHOULDN'T BE

ARC Restaurant + Bar offers the best of British Columbia flavours and the hotel's organic rooftop honey. Our 'plant-to-plate' philosophy uses vegetables and herbs grown in the rooftop garden in our seasonally changing menus. ARC features Ocean Wise seafood, craft beers, world-class wines and cool cocktails - try one of our bartender's creations featuring custom-blended spirits from BC craft distillery Wayward Distillery. The Chef's Bench offers communal dining, and a private dining room is perfect for intimate gatherings. During the summer months, a three-course pollinator menu features over a dozen items that require bees in order to flourish.



EVEN OUR MEETINGS ARE GREEN

Fairmont Waterfront has a 4 Green Key Meetings rating from Green Key Global. Fairmont's Eco-Meet program offers planners the opportunity to minimize their ecological footprint by reducing waste and conserving resources through four key components: Eco-Accommodation, Eco-Cuisine, Eco-Service and Eco-Programming. Meeting planners can request food leftovers be donated to local charities, request refreshments be offered in reusable containers, and encourage using computers rather than paper handouts for meetings.

ALL PACKAGED UP

Learn the history of the land with our Talking Trees Package. Explore the majesty of Stanley Park just minutes from the hotel with your own First Nations guide from Talaysay Tours, then go on a culinary adventure at Salmon n' Bannock, Vancouver's only Indigenous owned and run restaurant. The Bee Sustainable Package offers a close look at nature in the middle of the city with a guestroom that opens onto our rooftop garden, private tour of the rooftop apiary, and a jar of the hotel's organic honey. Available June through August, it also includes a three-course dinner for two from the pollinator menu in ARC and a \$10 donation to Hives for Humanity for every room sold to support the Pollinator Corridor project.

The Family Package offers more room and discounts on dining for the entire - or extended - family to enjoy. The package includes connecting rooms with 50% off the second room, an in-room movie each day, and board games upon arrival (on request). Children five and under eat free and ages six to 12 are half price. Local slopes, historical Gastown, Chinatown, Stanley Park and the Vancouver Aquarium are just a few of the attractions that can keep kids of all ages occupied! The hotel is conveniently located across from FlyOver Canada, a four-dimensional experience of the country.
