2 Udine and San Daniele

Guided walking tour of Udine, introducing the city's historic centre and Venetian-influenced architecture. The day continues in San Daniele with a stop at a local ham producer to learn about the curing process, followed by a tasting of the prized Prosciutto di San Daniele with a glass of Prosecco.

The tour continues through the Collio wine region, with a traditional farmhouse lunch and a tasting of local wines.

2 Monferrato and Spumante

Tour through the rolling hills of the Monferrato wine region, with a stop at a local cellar for a tasting of Barbera, the region's signature red wine. 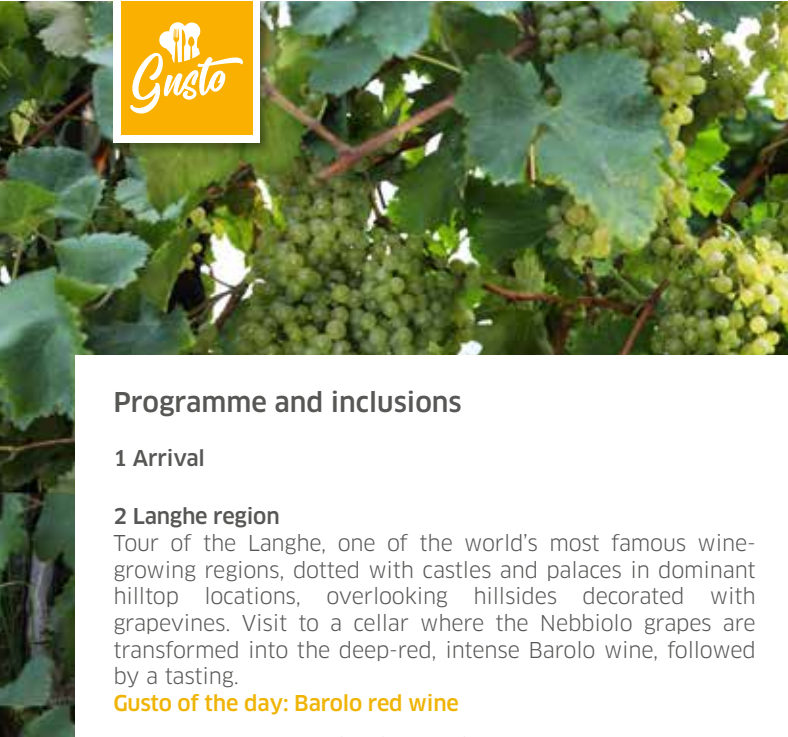

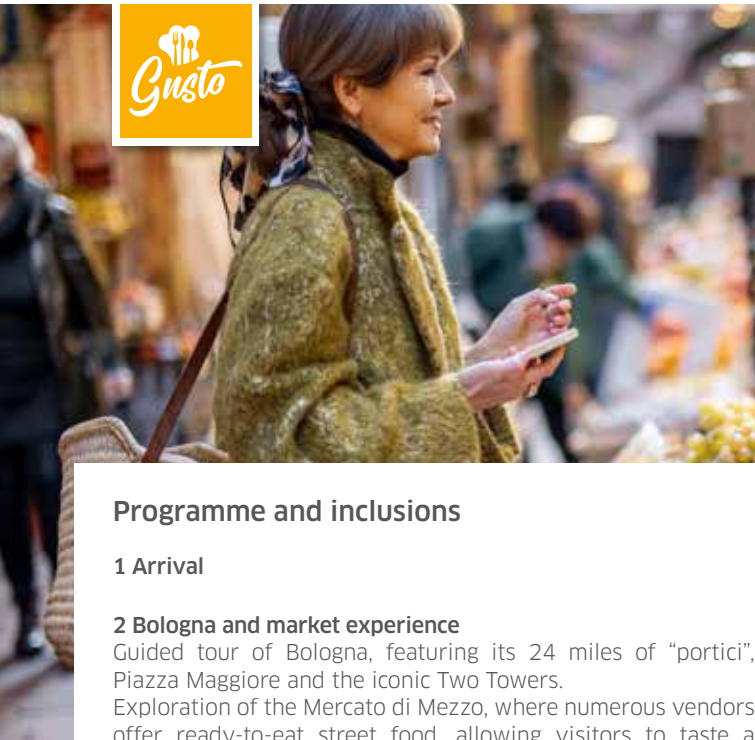

2 Roman-Jewish Food Heritage Tour

Exploration of Rome's historic Jewish Quarter, one of Europe's oldest Jewish communities. The tour winds through the atmospheric streets of Rione Sant'Angelo, past landmarks such as the Portico d'Ottavia and centuries-old synagogues.
